Bronze/Brass statues



Bronze (an alloy of copper and tin) and brass (an alloy of copper and zinc) sculptures have long history in India. Bronze is more brittle than brass but is well suited for molding since it expands on cooling providing sharp replicas. The brass mold shown here is that of Lord Shiva in form of a dancer of Heaven Natraj (dance +king).
