

Kolam/Rangoli





Kolam (கோலம்) or rangoli is a rice-flour drawing done on the thresholds of Indian households by women and girls early in the mornings and early evenings. They are meant to be a welcome sign to the visitors. Kolam and rangoli with colored design can be very complex and large occupying several square feet. Rice-flour use is symbolic since humans want to share their food with small animals like ants and birds.
